I am writing to inform you that on June 25, 2015, the Committee on Accreditation (COA), on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of **Accreditation** to the San Joaquin County Office of Education and all of its credential programs.

Furthermore, at the request of San Joaquin County Office of Education, the COA approved the withdrawal of the following programs, effective June 25, 2015.

- Designated Subjects: Preliminary Career and Technical Education
- Designated Subjects: Clear Career and Technical Education program
- Early Childhood Special Education Added Authorization
- General Education (Multiple and Single Subject) Induction
- Clear Administrative Services

In addition, the following programs have been deemed inactive as requested by SJCOE:

- Autism Spectrum Disorder Added Authorization
- Clear Education Specialist Induction
- Preliminary Administrative Services credential

On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to recommend candidates for the following credentials:

Multiple Subject Credential  
Multiple Subject Intern with Intern

Single Subject Credential  
Single Subject Intern with Intern

Education Specialist Credentials  
Mild/Moderate Disabilities with Intern  
Moderate/Severe Disabilities with Intern

Education Specialist: Early Childhood Education  
Education Specialist: Clear Induction (inactive)  
Added Authorization Autism Spectrum Disorder (inactive)

Administrative Services  
Preliminary Administrative Services (inactive)


Added Authorization: Mathematics Instruction

In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- San Joaquin County Office of Education is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- San Joaquin County Office of Education continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities, subject to the continuation of the present schedule of accreditation activities by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
