

Summary of Five-Year Teacher Retention Data

In the fall of 2016, Teachers College of San Joaquin administered a survey to all the credential graduates of 2011, seeking information pertaining to their retention as an educator. Graduates pooled were from our general education – multiple subjects, single subject, and career technical education; special education – early childhood, mild/ moderate, moderate/ severe; and, preliminary administrative services credentials. Of the 89 total candidates in 2011, 74 responded to our survey (83% response rate).

Of the 74 candidates:

- 66 (89%) are still in the field of education
- 3 (4%) are retired, one has returned to substitute
- 3 (4%) are not teaching
- 1 (1.4%) declined to state
- 1 (1.4%) is deceased (response from her husband)
