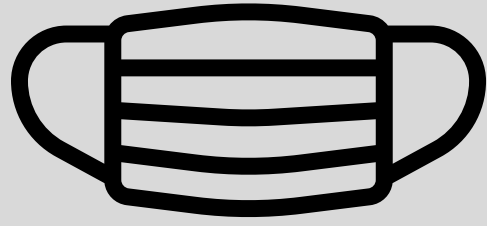


INSTRUCTOR PROTOCOLS REGARDING COVID-19

Teachers College of San Joaquin (TCSJ) and the San Joaquin County Office of Education (SJCOE) follow the guidance of local, state, and federal public health agencies when addressing confirmed coronavirus cases among its students, faculty and staff. The SJCOE is in regular contact with the San Joaquin County Public Health Services (SJCPHS) and has protocols in place to ensure quick and decisive communication and action as needed. Our decisions are guided by the safety and welfare of our campus community and our goal of providing a quality educational experience for our students.



As of January 9, 2024, masks are recommended while indoors at a TCSJ campus if positive for COVID-19 but not experiencing symptoms.

PLEASE FOLLOW THE BELOW RECOMMENDATIONS SET FORTH BY THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH (CDPH):

INSTRUCTORS WHO TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 AND HAVE SYMPTOMS



Everyone, regardless of vaccination status

STAY HOME.

- Stay home until you have been fever-free for 24 hours without using fever reducing medication AND other COVID-19 symptoms are mild and improving.
- Avoid contact with people at higher risk of severe COVID-19 for 10 days.
- Seek treatment. If you have symptoms, speak with a healthcare provider as soon as you test positive.

2. Work with your TCSJ coordinator to create a plan for your class(es) when unable to teach.

INSTRUCTORS WHO TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 AND DO NOT HAVE SYMPTOMS



Everyone, regardless of vaccination status

MASK INDOORS. (NO QUARANTINE REQUIRED).

- Mask when you are around other people indoors for the 10 days after you become sick or test positive.
- You do not need to isolate or quarantine.
- Avoid contact with people at higher risk of severe COVID-19 for 10 days.

INSTRUCTORS WHO ARE EXPOSED TO COVID-19 AND DO NOT HAVE SYMPTOMS



Everyone, regardless of vaccination status

TEST WITHIN 5 DAYS AFTER EXPOSURE. (NO QUARANTINE REQUIRED).

- Test within 5 days after exposure, if you are at higher risk of severe COVID-19 infection and would benefit from treatment.
- You do not need to isolate or quarantine.
- If you have contact with people who are at higher risk of severe infection, you should mask indoors when around such people for 10 days.
